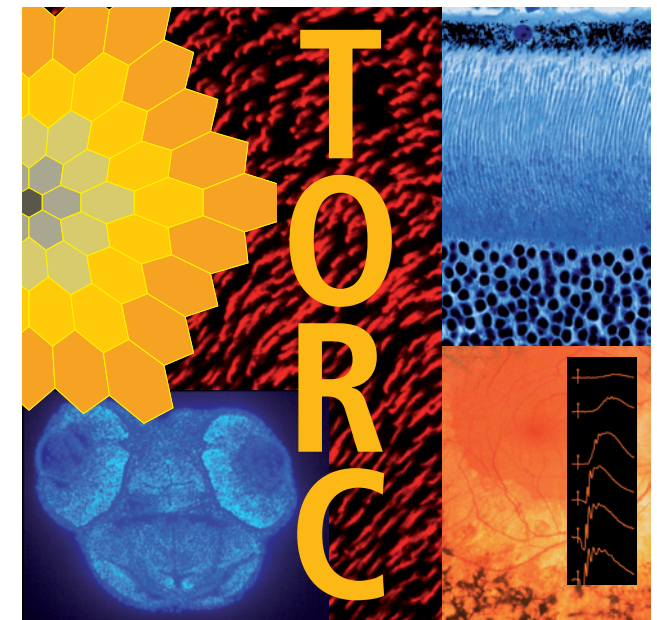

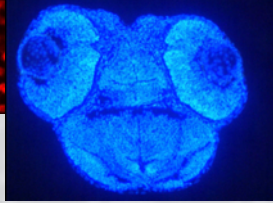

The program will cover all aspects of the outer retina from photoreceptors, channels and connections to bipolar and Mueller cells, and from basic mechanisms and animal models to human disease diagnostics and treatment.

Each day the scientific part will start with an introductory plenary lecture. Monday morning there will be official words from the state government and the university, followed by morning and afternoon scientific sessions.
